Rules & Regulations

- **Participants must be at least 21 years of age** and must have proper identification at check-in.
- **No electricity available**
- Teams will receive 3ft space to prepare and present their drink of choice, **the type of liquor used must be listed.**
- Each team will be assigned a number for judging purposes at check-in.
- Check-in time is 9:30 AM on Saturday, July 22nd at the Historical Comanche Courthouse Square
- **Beverage entries may not be pre-mixed.** All ingredients will be inspected by the committee prior to the competition.
- Only 2 members of the team are allowed to make the drink of choice.
- **Fire is not allowed** as a special effect during the making or serving of the drink.
- Any type of glassware is allowed for the final presentation (contestants must furnish their own glassware)
- **Frozen drinks are not allowed.**
- **Each team must provide at least 5 gallons of their drink entry.**
- Drink presentation and judging will take place at 10:00 AM
- Decorating, themes, and showmanship are encouraged. Decorating your area is also encouraged.
- The same cocktail must be served to both the public and judges.
- A 2 oz. sample cup will be sold to the public for \$10 per cup to sample the cocktails. Only those who have purchased a cup are allowed to receive a sample.
- **All people working in participant booths serving alcoholic beverages must be 21 years of age or older.**
- **No entries will be accepted once the contest begins.**
- Trash receptacles will be on site, and the participants responsible for cleaning and disposing of their area after judging and sampling.

- **Maximum of 15 teams**
- **No electricity available**
- **Not limited to salsa only, dips are allowed**
- Teams will receive 3ft space to prepare and present their salsa/dip
- Teams are assigned a number for judging purposes at check-in.
- Check-in time is 9:30 AM on Saturday, July 22nd at the Historical Comanche Courthouse Square
- The contest will take place inside of Homestead Hall
- **Judging will take place at 10:00 AM and entries will no longer be accepted at that time**
- Only 2 members of a team are allowed to present (1) salsa/dip. Additional salsa/dips will be considered as a different entry
- **Fire is not allowed**
- Any type of dishware is allowed for the final presentation (contestants must furnish their own dishware)
- **Each team must provide at least 3 gallons of their salsa/dip entry.**
- Decorating, themes, and showmanship are encouraged. Decorating your area is also encouraged.
- The same salsa/dip must be served to both the public and judges.
- The Chamber will provide paper serving cups that the public can use to sample the salsa/dips.
- Trash receptacles will be on site, and the participants responsible for cleaning and disposing of their area after judging and sampling.
