

2024 RULES & REGULATIONS

Please email <u>comancheevents@gmail.com</u> for any questions or concerns. This is the recommended form of communication in regards to your application and Pow Wow.

- 1. A signed entry form must be received with payment to secure your booth. First-time exhibitors must send a photo. Everyone must receive their final vendor packet; the final vendor packet will be sent per the selected method on the entry form. If you have not received your vendor packet call or email by Sep. 18th for confirmation. Please present your packet before entering the park.
- 2. All vendors selling food must comply with the Texas Department of Health's safe food guidelines.
- 3. No animals are allowed in food areas. (See dog ordinance)
- 4. EXHIBITORS will be responsible for all display needs: CANOPIES, TABLES, CHAIRS, EXTENSION CORDS, & GENERATOR.
- 5. Early set-up: Friday, Sept. 27, 2024, from 9:00 am until 6:00 pm. Saturday and Sunday set up time is from 7:00 am 9:30 am on both.
- 6. Exhibitors MUST KEEP BOOTHS OPEN UNTIL CLOSING TIME EACH DAY (no cars will be allowed back in until festival closing)
- 7. Exhibitors who leave early will not be invited back. NO EXCEPTIONS. One parking pass per vendor and only that vehicle will be allowed past the gates on Saturday and Sunday during set-up & tear down.
- 8. Vehicles **MUST** be removed to the designated parking outside the park, behind the City Pool, or other parking area by 9:30 AM on both Saturday and Sunday. A park shuttle will be provided!
- 9. Vehicles MUST be removed to the designated parking area outside the park, behind the City Pool, or other designated parking area by 9:30 AM on both Saturday and Sunday. Unless vehicle has a clearly visible handicapped sign, parking is not allowed in front of the City Pool. Vehicles parked in front of the City Pool could be at risk of being towed. A park shuttle will be provided!
- 10. **OVERNIGHT SECURITY PROVIDED** Friday & Saturday nights. No one is allowed in the park/vendor area (even vendors) from 10:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.
- 11. **Overnight camping** is permitted on Cherokee Street near the City Park (no hook-ups available).
- 12. The Pow-Wow reserves the right to refuse any vendor application!
- 13. NO REFUNDS RAIN OR SHINE. No refunds for cancellations after July 1st.
- 14. Most booths are 12W X 24DEEP foot.
- 15. You will be allowed <u>ONE electric outlet</u> if purchased. Outlets are limited!! <u>No 220 outlets available.</u> (Cords NOT provided)
- 16. Generators are allowed & are strongly recommended. If you bring a generator, you are responsible for fueling it.
- 17. Vendors cannot close or pack up their booths before closing time unless they have prior permission from the head Pow Wow personnel. This is a strict rule and will be strongly enforced. Any vendor in violation of this rule will not be allowed back at any future Pow Wows. You are responsible for the setup and tear down of your booth.
- 18. Storage vehicles are not allowed in the park area during Pow Wow unless otherwise pre-approved. High-clearance vehicles are not allowed in the park, and NO 18-wheelers are allowed.
- 19. No utility vehicles or motorized vehicles are allowed in the park. Including golf carts, gators, ATVs, etc...(Contact us for other arrangements)
- 20. All other applications are accepted based on booth availability.
- 21. No Wi-Fi in the park. Personal hotspots will have to be used if needed.

NO VENDORS ACCEPTED ON THE DAY OF POW WOW.

There will be a \$30 fee for returned checks.

DOG GUIDELINES/ Ordinance

Vendors or participants in the Pow Wow may bring a dog into the park with the following stipulations:

• The dog must always remain on a short leash and the owner of the dog must have proof of current immunizations, etc.

- The dog must remain with the owner at all times.
- A dog must be attended by an adult over 18 at all times.
- The owner of the dog must be responsible for picking up and disposing of all animal waste.
 Any dog owner not abiding by these rules will be asked to be removed from the park.

BANNED ITEMS

For safety concerns and respect for vendor's merchandise, the following toy/novelty items will be banned from sale during the Comanche County Pow Wow:

- Hand blasters, snappers, poppers 1.
- Disappearing ink
- 2. 3. Champagne or bottle poppers
- 4. 5. Water weenies/water guns Silly String, violent-like toys
- 6. 7. 8. Fake cigarettes of any kind
- No type of pornographic items Potato/Marshmallow guns or shooters
- <u>9</u>. Smoke bombs and stink bombs
- 10. Chemical or exploding items
- Any sharp or dangerous toys, no toy swords or knives 11.
